

## *Investiture of a Sixer*

The investiture of a sixer is more flexible than other Cub ceremonies. What follows is one possible way to perform it. You may want to design your own ceremony, keeping the general guidelines in mind. Usually you perform the ceremony after the opening Grand Howl.

1. Tell a *short* yarn explaining the importance of the sixer position.
2. Call the new sixer forward. If there are more than one, call them one at a time. Ask the sixer to repeat the promise or a special promise of your design: for example...

“I promise to do my best,  
To help the Cubs in my six and the Old Wolves,  
And to lead the \_\_\_\_ (colour) six as well as I can.”

3. Present the new sixer his sixer’s epaulettes.
4. Ask the sixer to return to his six, where the other members shake his hand as a symbol of their acceptance.
5. If your pack rotates sixers, thank by name each of the sixers whose terms have expired.
