## *What is a World Scout Jamboree?*

Every four years, tens of thousands of Scouts & Venturers, from every corner of the world, gather in a tented city for two weeks of activities and adventure!

This is a fantastic event where up to 30,000 Scouts & Venturers live and learn together. This is an amazing first-hand experience of multi-culturalism in action, an opportunity to interact and participate with others from different cultures and to build solidarity and understanding across cultural and geographical boundaries.

This is a World Scout Jamboree!



## *Who attends a World Scout Jamboree?*



Aimed at 14 to 17 year olds, Scouts & Venturers attend the event in national groups, called Contingents. There is one contingent from each country where there are Scouts recognised by the World Organisation of the Scout Movement (WOSM), and currently there are 160 member countries in WOSM! The event is supported by thousands of international adult volunteers. This is a peace building exercise on an enormous scale!

**Young people aged between 14 and 17 years old at the start of the camp (that is those born between 25th July 1993 and 27th July 1997) may take part in the 22nd World Scout Jamboree as Participants.**

**Those aged 18 and above (those born on or before 24 July 1993) should apply to be members of the International Service Team (IST).**

**The recruitment of Unit Leaders is a high priority as the youth participants need adult support. Without Unit Leaders, youth cannot attend the World Jamboree. Unit leaders live in the subcamps, on the unit site, and support the unit in all their daily activities.**



## *Where and When is the next World Scout Jamboree?*

**The next World Scout Jamboree will take place from July 27 2011 to August 07 2011.**

The Jamboree will be held on the fields of Rinkaby, not far from the town of Kristianstad, in the province of Skåne, in the south of Sweden.



## *How do we attend the next World Scout Jamboree?*

### *Contingents*

Contingents are the representative national groups that come to the World Scout Jamboree and there is only one contingent per country. Contingents are the organising groups which makes the preparations for Scouts from their countries to attend the Jamboree...which involves a great deal of work!

### The Patrol

Nine (9) youth and one (1) leader comprise a patrol. A patrol can be youth and a leader from one community, or can be made up of youth from across Canada!

### The Unit

Four (4) Patrols, IE thirty-six (36) youth and four (4) leaders make up a Jamboree Unit. Most of the formal Jamboree program activities are based on a Unit.

**Our number one priority is to get youth to the World Jamboree. Scouts Canada and l'Association des Scouts du Canada are planning to take at least 500 Canadians to the World Scout Jamboree in Sweden!**

## International Service Team (IST)

**International Service Team members are also part of the Contingent.** To be in the International Service Team (IST) at the 22nd World Scout Jamboree in Sweden 2011, you must be an active Scout, and you need to have turned 18 at the start of the camp. That means you must have been born on or before the 24 July 1993.

Members of the IST should be able to speak English and/or French and be prepared to take on any task needed to create the Jamboree. IST must arrive on site 25 July 2011 and can leave 8 August 2011.

The 22nd World Scout Jamboree in Sweden 2011 will have over 6000 Scouts working on the International Service Team. These older Scouts will help with all areas of the Jamboree, making it possible for us to deliver a fantastic experience to all our participants.

To apply to come to the World Scout Jamboree, you need to register with the National Contingent from your country.

## *Costs*

The Canadian Contingent Registration Fee for the 22<sup>nd</sup> World Jamboree is estimated at \$4400.00 per participant and \$4000 for volunteers on the International Service Team (IST).

Included in the fee will be all transportation costs including transfers in Europe, jamboree fees, food while at the jamboree, patrol cooking equipment, additional insurance, pre-jamboree events, tents and a Canadian Contingent kit (jacket, neckerchief, contingent crests etc.)

What is not included? Spending money, personal clothing and sleeping bag etc.
