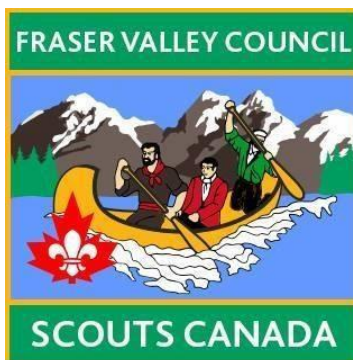

When parents start with 'yes, and', to their kids' idea, their child is empowered to take the lead, explore new skills and discover their thing.

Scouts Canada surveyed a focus group of 145 youth (between the ages of 5 and 14) and 368 parent members to determine what activities Canadian kids wish their parents would say 'yes' to.

The 1st Aiders App to Save on Paperwork!



The ScoutSafe app makes it a breeze when submitting incident reports.

All First Aiders should have this app as part of their kit!

- The use of ScoutSafe means that Scouters can also submit photos of the injury, site where the injury occurred, etc.
- Reports submitted via the app includes more information than a PDF incident report – that

means less follow-up questions for Scouters to answer!

- Submitting reports via ScoutSafe means that reports are submitted and received in real time – that means a more timely response from Safe Scouting with support resources and check ins on the injured party.
- >> After submitting a report, reporting parties can easily save the incident report as a PDF to their device and share with the Group for records keeping if necessary
