Scouts Canada’s Screening Policy requires all applicants and members 18 years of age and older to provide a “Police Records Check”. New adult members—except Rover Scouts—also require a “Vulnerable Sector Search” prior to acceptance with the Organization.

As members of a youth-serving organization, all volunteers will have some interaction with youth 5 to 17 years of age. Section Scouters routinely engage directly with youth, providing appropriately challenging activities through weekly meetings and overnight/camping experiences. Volunteers in other roles support Section Scouters and youth Participants; they may attend activities and events periodically throughout the program year, as well as having access to personal information of members.
