Where is Woodland Trails Camp/Adventureland located?

Woodland Trails Camp is located at 14919 Kennedy Road in Whitchurch-Stouffville. We are central to Markham, Aurora and Newmarket north of the GTA. Our nearest intersection is Kennedy Road and Aurora side road, just off the 404!

What types of camping is Woodland Trails/Adventureland offering for the summer of 2022?

Woodland Trails Camp is pleased to offer a variety of camping options for the summer of 2022, including Adventureland Day Camp, Day only Leaders In Training Program as well as Adventureland Weekend Family Camps.

It is possible that overnight options will be added at a later date.

Does Woodland Trails/Adventureland offer youth Day Camp programs?

Yes, for summer 2022, Woodland Trails/Adventureland is pleased to once again be offering weekly summer Day Camps starting on July 4 and ending August 26, 2022. Day Camps for youth ages 6–12 will be offered on a weekly basis from Monday to Friday and will provide youth a variety of interactive, engaging outdoor activities.

What is the age range for youth Day Camps?

For the summer of 2022, Adventureland is pleased to be offering our traditional youth Day Camp programming for all youth ages 6–12.

What type of programming can my child expect at Adventureland's Day Camp?

Adventureland's Day Camp programs are focused on fun and exciting outdoor programming. With great on-site amenities, youth can expect their day to be filled with activities such as swimming (in our Olympic-sized pool), soccer, basketball, mountain biking, archery, and trail hikes. We also have a bouldering (climbing) wall, beach volleyball courts and a ball hockey area. Additional activities include tennis/badminton/pickle ball courts, survival lessons, laser tag, trapping/logging, community gardening, wood working, arts and crafts and a special weekly theme activity!

How much is Day Camp or LIT?

Adventureland's weekly Day Camp and LIT Day program are offered at \$249 as a special early bird rate, and \$299 after that.

Do I have to register my child for a full week of Day Camp or LIT?

Yes, youth must be registered for the week.

When do Adventureland Day Programs start?

The first week of Day Camps begin Monday July 4 to 8 and are offered weekly throughout the summer. The final week of Day Camp is August 22 to August 26.

What are the daily drop-off and pick-up times for Day Camp?

Day Camp program will operate Monday–Friday, 9am–5pm with drop off between 8–9 and pick up between 5–6.

Adventureland Weekend Family Camp

What is Weekend Family Camp?

Woodland Trails/Adventureland is opening to Scouting families again this summer for family camping. Families will be able to enjoy the property and amenities, along with on-site, instructor-led programming, for a genuine Scouts Canada experience. Guests will be required to maintain their family bubble and stay safely distanced from others at all times while on-site. Proof of vaccination may be required.

What is included in Weekend Family Camp?

Amenities and programming vary by each camp, but families can expect a range of amenities and instructor-led programming including, but not limited to: archery, hiking, geocaching, swimming, wood working, mountain biking, tent sites, cabins and even a caboose! Private campfires are available for overnight guests.

When is Woodland Trails Camp/Adventureland open for Weekend Family Camp?

Woodland Trails Camp is looking forward to welcoming families for weekend camping beginning July 8 to August 28, 2022. Family camping is only offered at Woodland Trails on weekends—Friday to Sundays throughout the summer. Families who book a weekend stay may choose to add a Thursday or Monday to their visit for a longer stay.

For Weekend Family Camp, how many tent sites are available to book at Woodland Trails Camp?

Families can choose from eight (8) secluded tent sites.

For Weekend Family Camp, how many cabins are available to book at Woodland Trails Camp?

Woodland Trails Camp is offering four (4) fully equipped cabins to book.

For Weekend Family Camp, how many villages are available to book at Woodland Trails Camp?

Woodland Trails has five (5) village settings to book for tent camping.

For Weekend Family Camp, how many caboose cars are available to book at Woodland Trails Camp?

Woodland Trails is offering one (1) caboose for overnight guests.

How much does it cost to book a tent/village/cabin/caboose?

All prices are per household:

Tent Site: \$70 per night or \$149 per weekend (includes access to all instructor-led weekend programming)

Village: \$120 per night or \$249 per weekend (includes access to all instructor-led weekend programming)

Cabin: \$160 per night or \$399 per weekend (includes access to all instructor-led weekend programming)

Premium Cabin (Big Pine): \$180 per night or \$425 per weekend (includes access to all instructor-led weekend programming)

Caboose: \$140 per night or \$299 per weekend (includes access to all instructor-led weekend programming)

For Weekend Family Camp, how many nights can I book at a site?

Family Adventure Camp is only offered on weekends throughout the summer, families can book two nights (Fridays and Saturdays) but may choose to add a Thursday or Monday to their stay for a longer weekend visit.

Can I book only one night of Family Camping?

There is limited single night availability for our caboose rental and lodge rentals only. You can find out more by reaching out at adventureland@scouts.ca

What amenities are available at Woodland Trails Camp/Adventureland?

Woodland Trails Camps offer a variety of amenities, including a massive outdoor pool, picnic areas, hiking trails, weekend Instructor-led programming, self-guided programming, washroom facilities (flush or kybo depending on rental type), dining shelters and drinking water access for overnight guests.

What type of weekend Instructor-led programming is available at Woodland Trails Camp?

Woodland Trails is offering a variety of great programming including: Swimming, Archery, Mountain Biking, Ecology/Outdoor Education sessions, Trapping & Logging, Survival, Star Hikes/Astronomy, Wood Working, Arts and Crafts and Laser Tag.

These weekend programs are available to all Adventureland Weekend Family Camp guests.

Will washrooms and showers be available?

Showers will only be available at the pool as part of the pre-swim process. Tent camping guests will have access to kybos in public areas and cabin guests will have either private flush toilets if booking a lodge or private kybos if booking a village or site. Please note the caboose facility does not have indoor washrooms.

Are there laundry facilities?

There are no laundry facilities at Woodland Trails Camp.

Can I bring my pet?

No, pets are not permitted on Scouts Canada properties.

Do I need to bring my own water, or is drinking water available on site?

All weekend overnight guests will have access to drinking water.

What is the check-in/out times for Weekend Family Camp?

Woodland Trails will be open to the public from Thursday to Monday starting July 8 and continuing through to August 28.

Monday: 11am–5pm

Tuesday: 10am–11am (for checkout only)

Wednesday: CLOSED

Thursday: 5pm (for check in only)

Friday: 9am–7:30pm

Saturday: 9am–5pm

Sunday: 9am–5pm

Can I bring my tent-trailer/camper/RV?

Tent-trailers, campers, and RVs are not permitted on property.

Is there an on-site Tuck Shop or Canteen?

Yes. We recommend the maple syrup, harvested right on site :)

For Weekend Family Camp, is alcohol permitted?

There shall be no illegal drug/substance or alcohol consumed on property as per Scouts Canada policy. This is a family camp model with youth on-site; as such, we have a clear obligation to care for and ensure the safety of everyone participating in our programs and activities.

Is Woodland Trails a smoke-free property?

Yes.

What are my options for firewood?

Guests are prohibited from bringing in their own wood due to the invasive species damaging wood lots in Ontario. Guests are able to purchase firewood on site at the camp office.
