### **Removal of Vaccine Mandate**

As communicated to members on Sunday June 12, the Board has made the decision to lift the mandatory vaccination requirement for members age 12+ as of **September 1, 2022**. Until that time, the policy remains in effect.

An email to parents notifying them of this policy change was sent on Tuesday June 14, along with updates to the News & Events page and the COVID-19 FAQ page. As stated in the email, the significant uptake of vaccinations across the country has contributed to the re-evaluation of the policy. This change is also in line with many private sector companies, other youth serving organizations, educational institutions, and health agencies.

Scouts Canada continues to strongly encourage our members to be vaccinated against COVID-19 and will continue to follow all federal, provincial and local regulations as it relates to the COVID-19 pandemic, which includes revisiting this policy should circumstances about the pandemic change once again.
