

SAFETY WEEK

Promoting Positive Behaviour & Managing Challenging Situations

The [Promoting Positive Behaviour and Managing Challenging Situations guideline](#) is full of best practices to help Scouters set youth up for success by promoting positive behaviour, and tips on how to address and change challenging behaviour.

Let's support all youth to be successful in Scouting:

- Use the Section Code of Conduct (example at the back of the Promoting Positive Behaviour and Managing Challenging Situations guideline) to clearly set behaviour expectations and explain potential consequences if the expectations aren't met.
- Follow through on the agreed-upon consequences when appropriate
- Don't forget to praise the really great accomplishments. Accomplishments aren't always obviously monumental – sometimes self-regulation (like sitting quietly at a ceremony) is something to be recognized and celebrated, for example.

Addressing challenging behaviours can typically be managed within the Section, and there's always additional support when needed. Reach out to parents, the Group Support Scouter, Group Commissioner, Relationship Manager, and beyond. We're here to help.
