



## **Update**

We currently have a member of our team work on the backlog of the Certificate of Commendation (CoC) flashes for all twenty Councils. The backlog is to get every group whole up to March 31, 2023. Starting April 1, 2023 it will be the groups' responsibility to purchase them from scoutshop.ca. Currently, the CoCs are out of stock. The target is to have them back in stock for the Fall, so Groups will be able to purchase them in bulk, and present them in a timelier fashion.

Recognition is also working on organizing a mailing for the backlog of Long Service medals. If there is a Recognized Date with the 02/22 with the year ending in 2020-2023, that will be included in that mailing.

## Group Bulk Order App!



The retail team is happy to announce the upcoming rollout of several features designed to address some of the most common feedback we receive from our members:

- *shipping costs and difficulty determining the correct size of uniform to order.*

We have worked with an outside developer and our fulfillment partner, Lowe-Martin, to create a custom feature to Scoutshop.ca that will allow for groups to place orders whereby every participant can purchase their own order that will be combined into a group

order and shipped to a single location with no shipping charge.

To help with determining sizing we are working to create a series of videos illustrating how to properly measure for the correct size and have partnered with True Fit. True Fit is an app that allows users to enter some basic information about themselves and will then recommend which size to order.



## Uniform Inventory: Update

Looking for a uniform that is out of stock?

Our mass uniform order is expected to arrive in late August, replenishing the stock of everything that we have run out of early.

Unfortunately when planning for the 2022-23 scouting year back in the fall of 2021 it was quite difficult to know what our uniforms needs were going to be and we came up short in some areas. The lead time on a uniform order is 8-9 months. By the time we knew we would be short the next order had already been placed.

The retail team has worked hard to move this order up to replenish our uniform supply as quickly as possible.

We can appreciate how frustrating it is to be looking for something that is out of stock. In the meantime we invite you to sign up to be notified when your uniform is back in stock on the product page on Scoutshop.ca.

# SAFETY WEEK

## There's Safety....In Snacking?!?

As the warmer weather approaches, we are reminded by recent incident reports of youth experiencing fainting and overexertion that a nutritional snack and adequate hydration are a must before, during, and after activities:

- Ensure that everyone is fueled up in advance of the planned adventure. Sometimes, not everyone sees the instructions that say that participants should arrive already having eaten breakfast, for example.
- Double-check that participants are prepared with an adequate water source for the adventure
- Keep allergies in mind! Be aware of members' food allergies like nuts, eggs, dairy, and gluten, and be sure that snacks on the adventure are safe for everyone.
- Some youth need to be reminded to have a snack or to take a few gulps of water;

take time as a Patrol, Section, or Group to have a break and refuel with needed calories and fluids. Scouting can be strenuous!
